


### Message from Supervising Officer and Vice President, Gilbert Sun

# Sherman Chung

## An Artist with Indefinite Boundaries



Sherman is an awarded singer with many awarded songs and released more than 10 Albums during her career. Becoming a professional singer will require hard work. There's a lot of competition and to be successful ultimately requires a long-term commitment to doing the work and staying in the game. Especially after COVID-19, social distancing comes at a great price for both artists and audiences. How does Sherman adapt to shutdowns by swapping physical performance spaces for virtual ones? How does she find creative ways to keep people connected during a pandemic that keeps us apart?

### How do you handle your career under COVID-19, how to keep tracks of the things you need to do?

**Sherman:** This is a situation that no one can foresee. In the beginning, I also thought the pandemic would not last long, but now I believe everyone accepts the fact that the coronavirus is here for the long haul. We should not be completely at a loss about what to do. When you get driven to your wit's end, you don't know how to continue. Hence, I will not wait for the world to get better, we need to respond to the challenges by finding those hidden opportunities which will lead us toward the path of wealth and abundance.

### Don't be panic and react fast

These years I initiated several different projects by myself as an extension of my singing career, like the new channel with my sister Sukie and my online cooking tutorials, etc. Nowadays many things can be easily done through social media if an artist is willing to try. Even a normal individual can express themselves and promote anything they want to. Somehow, you will still need help during the making, but if you don't take the first step, it is very difficult for others to reach you. Start where you stand, and work with whatever tools you may have at your command, and better tools will be found as you go along.

### Diversify

Luckily I already have my own platform, I do a lot of different things online as there are fewer showcases during the pandemic. I will not limit myself to only singing and dancing. On the other hand, I have a passion to explore many areas although I still love music. I tried to sell teas, masks and other products which are comparatively less risky and pressure. I take this opportunity to try different things and do it step by step in order to minimize the risk.



Being an artist in the past, it is so standard, but now there are a lot of paths

**Sherman:**

In the past, it was more passive and standard. There were only a few channels where artists were made by regular formula. Nowadays, in the age of digital, we have seen big artists grow and develop not just their music, but brands as well. Fans and followers have acquired a taste more than just the music of the artist, but the whole portfolio of what the artist does and what they represent; which has become fairly easy to do from the listeners side as artists themselves utilize social media for this purpose. In this day and age, I find it to be strictly critical that those as the new millennials, begin to learn to have all these fundamental skills that would advance their use of the internet as a generation. Artists need to collaborate. All artists need to learn to work together in building a strong community of creatives. Just because I identify with myself as a musician, it does not necessarily mean I am limited to music. I create an alternative voice for myself; I start blogging, vlogging, drawing, designing, or even if it's addressing some of the frustrations I come across from within the industry, or just to show people a little more of my life as a musician.

Today, true fans want to know more than just the music, they love to get a look into the life or/and mind of the musician. That way they relate more to the music, because it comes from a place they understand. Content production has definitely gone a few notches beyond just music in the age of the internet.

As an artist, how would you classify yourself?

**Sherman:** I don't know the words to describe my style, because I'm capable of not only writing songs, I also like to dance. I can do anything I like. I don't want to categorize anything.



You were very good at piano when you were at a very young age, and your mother used to sing as well. Do you think your family has influenced you to become a singer??

**Sherman:** Absolutely because of my mother's influence. I reached classical music when I was just a baby because my mum was a professional Opera singer from Yunnan. After that, I got introduced to piano when I was just 4 years old. During that time, I was too young to understand anything and not even be able to reject it. But as time goes by, I have watched many concerts and performances. I realised that I am sensitive to music due to the musical experience I had from my childhood. Then when I was 15-16 years old, I started to dance and play hip hop music like most youngsters. Of course, I studied Music in University. Even though I liked drawing, I still prefer to perform on the stage. So I chose a career which I can perform. All of these things happened thanks to my mum, who gave me exposure to music since I was a baby. Now I am more mature in my career, I became more of a multi-talented artist, I can use my drawing skill to design, to create stuff for different projects. I also had my own exhibition. My drawing skill has become very useful for my career. I love what I do and I do what I love!



If anyone wants to be an artist, do you have any advice for them?

**Sherman:**

These days, Social Media, if I'm being super honest. I know it doesn't sound like the answer that people want, but it kind of is Tik tok or Instagram. I got signed after I won the signing contest, it was different during that time. So, now it's putting stuff online. I think you kind of have to put your pride aside, and don't expect someone to come find you. Be brave and put yourself out there. Sometimes it can be almost embarrassing because you feel like you're promoting yourself. But you just have to do it because everybody is, and there's so much noise online. But real talent really does cut through. You see it time and time again.

I think the biggest key to getting noticed in the music industry is focusing on being one-of-a-kind, unique, and bringing something to the table that no one else can. Know yourself and know what you are doing, don't force yourself to become someone you are not just for pleasing the audience, they are smart. When you own what you do, the passion shows, and people take notice.



Sherman innovates inside the box and does not let outside circumstances dictate her destiny. She was not waiting for the "next big idea" to find her, but to go do what she can with what she has, to create the best experiences for the people she serves. She reminds us the biggest thing people need to remember is to not stigmatize the hustle. Not make value statements on how much you are contributing as an artist based on how much you are struggling. It doesn't make you less of a singer or less of an artist if you have to pick up something else to pay your bills. Do not wait, the time will never be "just right"!

# Hank Cheng

**A Pilot who insist in handmade aircraft that fly around the world**



Hank Cheng is a pilot who led a project called "Inspiration" (香港起飛). The project is about the first-ever homebuilt aircraft certified to fly under Hong Kong registration.

Hank had a dream that he must build his own aircraft in Hong Kong and flying it around the world. Hank thought that the project shall be completed in 3 years; however, there were many hurdles such as license, sponsor, technique etc. for him. Hank expressed infectious enthusiasm of his dream to his team involved groups of secondary school students from St. Paul's Convent School and engineers from Cathay Pacific and Hong Kong Aircraft Engineering Company Limited (HAECO).

Now, his dream partly had become reality for seven years within his team. Starting and ending in Hong Kong, Inspiration will fly across all meridians. Inspiration will stop in around 50 airports of 25 countries, including Australia, USA, Great Britain, Italy and many more!

**May you briefly introduce your project of "Inspiration"?**

Hank: I had started the project since 2008, and it was about constructing a homebuilt aircraft in Hong Kong but I have never imagined that this project would attract loads of concerns and feedback. When I was little, I dreamed about flying my own aircraft and build it with my hands. This dream was inspire by playing LEGO and building model airplanes. At first, teaching students to work together on the project means a lot to me, therefore I was hoping to cooperating with a school. At the same time, I could save the cost of renting a huge area to build the aircraft. To be frank, this project would be a feasible and successful work in Hong Kong because it is very common in foreign countries.

**I know that there were many difficulties in your project such as licence, budget and other technical problems. Did you ever think of giving up on your project when you were facing those obstacles?**

Hank: There are definitely moments of doubt whether the project will succeed or not. Fortunately I have a great team of colleagues and friends who shared the same dream. There are also the students, who believed in me that this aircraft will fly, I just can't let them down. This has been one of the driven force for me to carry on and not giving up. Besides, I only focused on small goals every day, which is why I would persist on the project. For example, I would just finish a seat setting or painting for today, and I would not get distracted to complete all the works in a day. I understand that Rome was not built in a day, so does a dream. It would be easy to give up if I only focus on the outcome. Believing in myself is significant to me, because some people could make their own aircraft even just in their garage. Not to mention that I got a school and some engineers to support my project. Thus, I have a strong belief to finish my project.

**How did you solve the technical issues of constructing the aircraft when you don't have engineering knowledge?**

Hank: Nowadays, Internet is a powerful platform to solve most of the technical problems. There are many people out there who have already constructed their own aircraft in the world, consequently I could ask them through the Internet. Besides, other Hong Kong engineers have also advised me how to tackle the mechanical problems.

**Being a pilot is very busy and stays in Hong Kong seldomly. So how did you manage your time for your family and this project?**

Hank: Yes, Indeed, I could not stay in Hong Kong all the time. However, after work, I would spend about 2 hours to focus on my project. No matter how much time I have got, I would achieve my little task for the project every day. Otherwise, the project would be given up if I skip it day by day. Once you have stopped working, you would begin to lose momentum, you need to keep going.





**I know that you also worked with your students for constructing the aircraft. Do you have any interesting experience to share? Did you learn anything from them?**

Hank: I had cooperated with St. Paul's Convent School which is a girl's school without any woodworking or metalworking courses for their students. Therefore, they were very curious to use the tools. I remembered that one of my students wondered if the aircraft would be exploded when they were using hammer or riveting the aircraft. After that, I explained the mechanism of building an aircraft to them. It was a very funny moment. This was my first time teaching students, which is very memorable to me. In addition, witnessing the students to tidy up the tools by themselves was surprising me. I realized that my students are keen to utilize the technology, for instance, when I asked them to design a poster, I was giving out the hand-drawing tools, however they chose to use smart devices. Hence, this project was definitely an unforgettable experience.


**Due to Covid-19, Hong Kong aviation industry is encountering a hard time. What is your challenges? How do you face and resist the pressure?**

Hank: During this pandemic, unable to fly an airplane was the significant pressure for me. As an optimistic person, I thought this could be a great opportunity to explore projects that I wouldn't have the time for. Some of my colleagues chose to study and learn a new hobby. For me, I started to run a woodworking workshop, as DIY is my passion. Some people said it could be anytime to begin aviation industry, it would be better to just wait and see the situation. Of course, I did not listen to their voice, but follow my gut and start running the workshop right away. It would not be happening if we have many aspects to considerate.

**JCI Publication is a platform which aims to encourage youngsters. What will you share to them?**

Hank: Making mistakes is an unavoidable process to be successful. There must be many difficulties while chasing your dreams. I believed that I am not the first one to build an aircraft and take off in Hong Kong. Nonetheless, the reason of my success is because of my persistence to achieve my dreams. Many people would think of different reasons to fail when they were facing obstacles, instead of finding out a better way of being successful. Indeed, it was hard to make your dreams come true. Those difficulties were act like a filter, losers would be faded out eventually and being persistence is the champion among the dreamers.

Being the first pilot who could fly his own hand-crafted airplane is a pioneering and legendary milestone in Hong Kong. No matter how many obstacles Hank has met, he would never give up until reaching his dreams. During this pandemic, Hank would still being optimistic to face it and operate his favourite woodworking workshop. Staying positive mindset, persistence and passion are the optimal elements to achieve your dreams.

# CHILDREN'S PLAYRIGHT

## Children's Play Rights

Children's Play Rights is the flagship project of JCI Tsuen Wan Communities Development area where it was promoted by the United Nation under the Convention on the Rights of the Child, Article 31, signed in 1989. It aims to remind and educate parents of the importance of PLAY before it's too late. Play is essential for children's development on language, analytical and decision-making skills.



**"Make Your Own Game" Online creative game production competition**  
Because of the COVID -19 epidemic, physical lessons for the younger children were suspended, and parents got more chances to spend time with their kids at home. Therefore our team organized an online competition for both parents and children to participate, hoping that they can use their creativity to make DIY games of their own. After that, we held an award ceremony to reward the participants who got the most "LIKE" of their games on Facebook. We had also shared their works to the public so everyone would know the joy and the fun of free play!

## Children's Play right questionnaires

We also collaborated with SRACP (香港善導會) to conduct a survey by distributing more than 500 questionnaires to 4 - 12 years old children. The research was led by Mr. Edison Lau and Miss Sophia Lai from SRACP and we got some good results such as Hong Kong children have more than 1 hour play time and parents play with their kids more than 0.5 hour under COVID -19. Besides having enough time for the children to play, it is necessary for the children to play the game in the right way. Therefore, we give recommendations to parents in response to provide quality playtime to their kids and the advantages of it.



## Promoted messages through Online

To help the parents to learn more about the definition of "Free Play" and the ways to play with their children from mother's and father's angle, we put videos on our Facebook and YouTube Channel for spreading the messages worldwide. We invited our project Ambassador - Marie Lime; Hang Kin Care Centre - Albert Leung; International Music Therapy Centre - Kingman Chung; Phycologist - Betsy Wong as the speakers of the videos. They shared useful information for parents and addressed the importance of Children's Play Rights. Already more than 2000 people watched the videos.



## Children's Play right theme song

The highlight of our project this year is a theme song for Children's Play Right! JCI TW cooperated with BNI to produce the theme song "讓小孩子遊玩". It opens up another opportunity for us to promote children's play right as well as parents should spend time accompanying their kids through watching the music video. Except our Facebook and YouTube Channels, the theme song is played on all the song charts of major radio stations.

Leadership development is one of the JCI value. We are glad that we have opportunities to hold different trainings for our members to build up members' leadership skill. And it also a chance to meet new friends.


## Officer Training Camp (Date: 21 ~ 22/11/2020)


